Curriculum:

- More learning areas for the children.
- More extra curriculum activity programs incorporated into the normal routine.



Teaching staff:

Our teachers have been carefully selected considering qualities of experience, commitment and enthusiasm and are recruited through an intensive rigorous campaign thus delivering the quality programme.

Co-curricular activities:

Our school provides maximum opportunities for the enrichment of children's experiences and learning skills.

Activities include;

Class size:

These are limited to a ratio of approximately 1:10 teacher: pupil ratio.

Children are received from **7:30am – 8:00am** and classes begin at **8:30am** promptly.

The school provides Lunch for all children 1:00 – 2:00pm.

Classes end at **03:00pm** Monday - Friday.

A fine of **5,000/=** is imposed for late picking.



School fees:

As the child is being enrolled in school a personalized account number is given; ensure all payments are made on the child's account using Mobile money, Bank agents or through the **Bank**. The system will automatically reflect your payment.

Please note that **no cash** is allowed in school. All money should be paid using the different payment modes availed to you above.

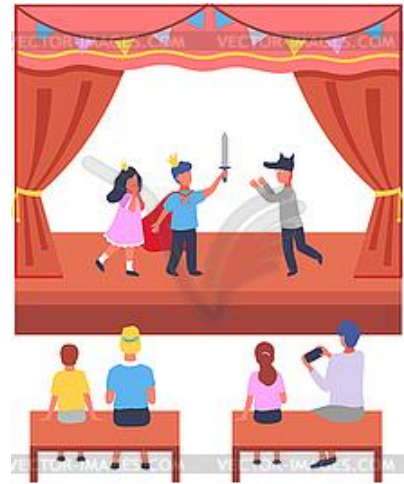
Absence
